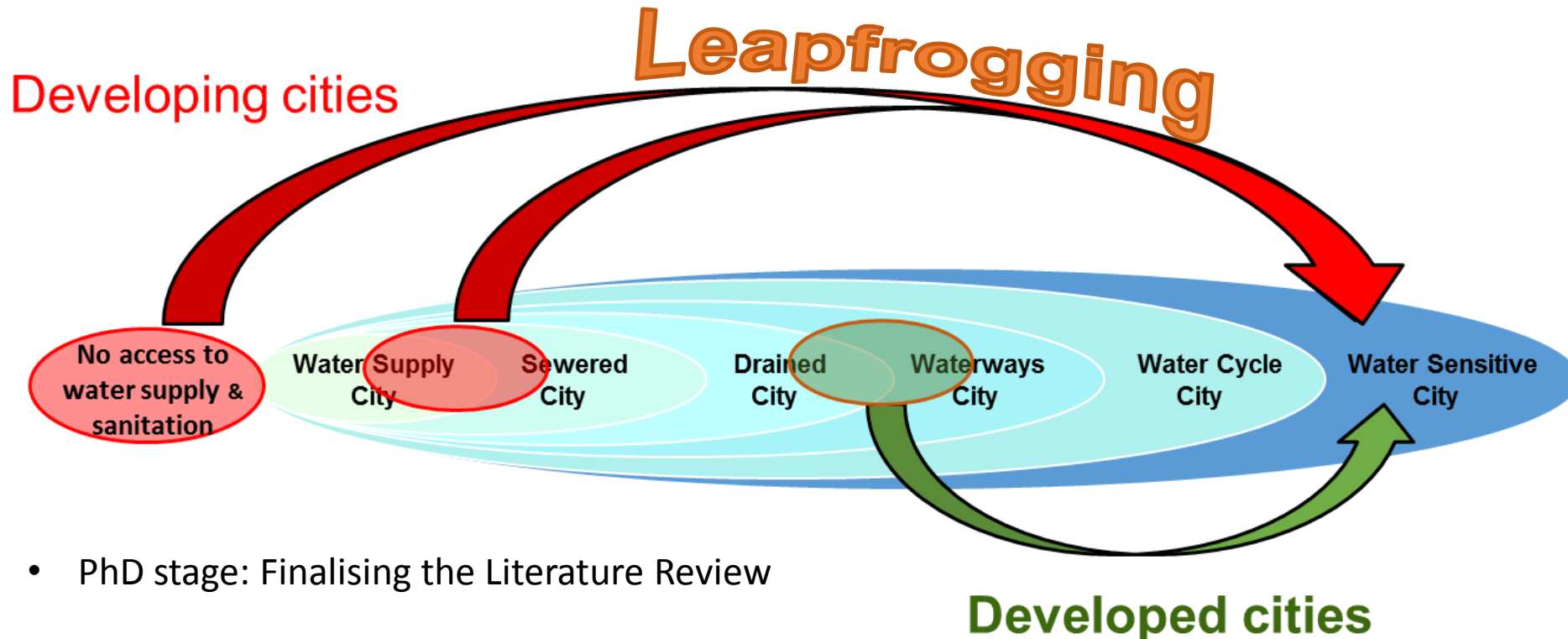

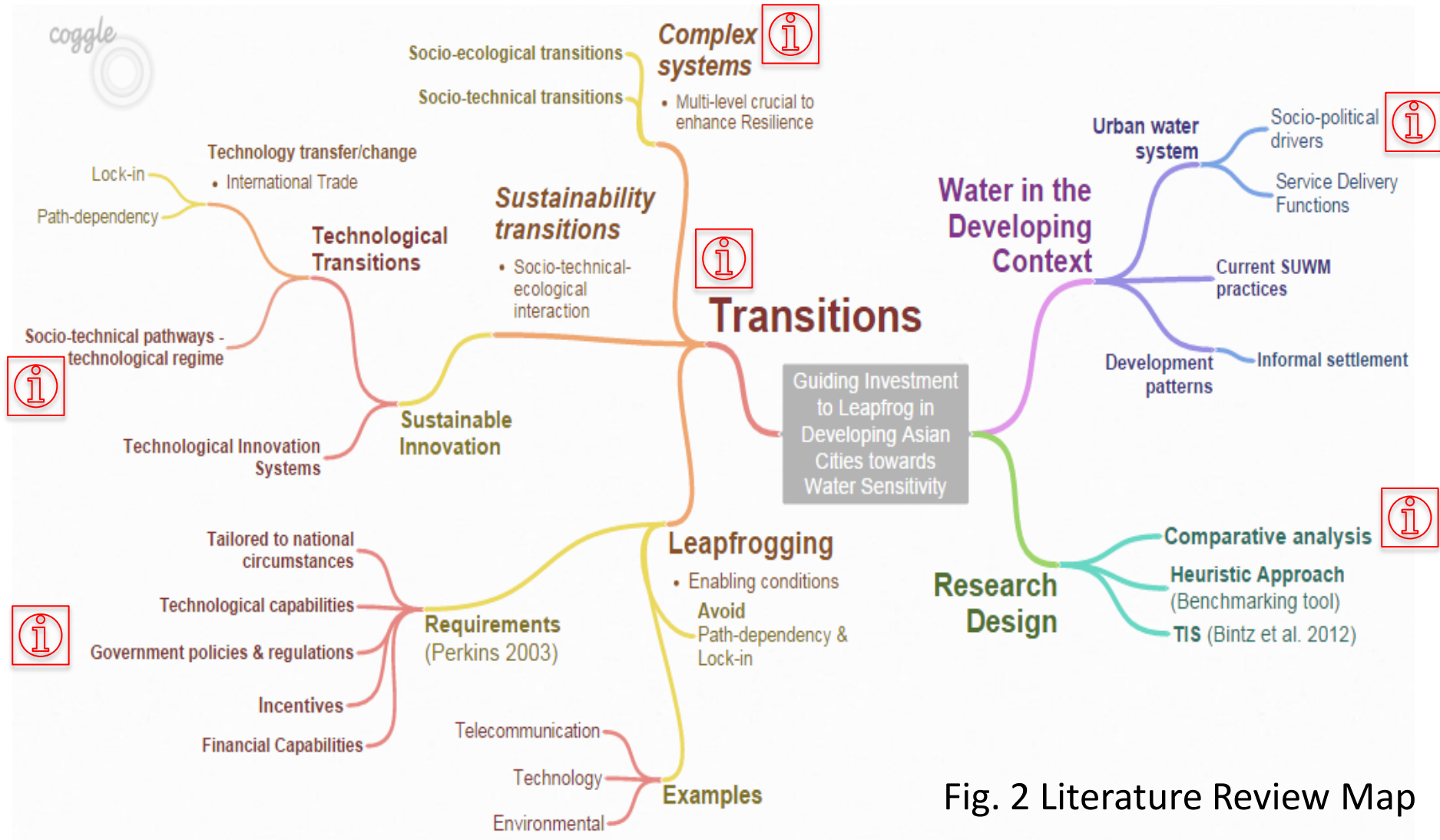


Fig. 2 Literature Review Map
